
Reclining Seats - Window seat lever is on the left side of seat cushion. Aisle seat lever is on the right side of seat cushion. Press lever back while leaning on seat back. Seat will recline 25%. To return to upright: lean away from seat back and press lever back. Seat will return to upright.



Footrests - Located at the bottom to seat-back in front of you for your comfort if needed.


Seat Belts - If our coach is equipped with seat belts, we require you to use them.


Reading light, Driver call button and Air Conditioner/ Fresh Air Valve - All located overhead of seat.

MOTORCOACH EMERGENCY GUIDE

Using Emergency Exits


Look for the emergency exits - in addition to the boarding door, there should be several window exits, and a rooftop exit or hatch. If you are seated beside a window emergency exit, and don't think you can operate it, move to another seat.

Windows are marked as emergency exits, with instructions to release the pull handle (Diagram A) or Lift Bar (Diagram B) windows push out to open. Follow the marked instructions to open the roof hatch (Diagram C).









EMERGENCY INSTRUCTIONS



Entering and Exiting Vehicle - Use handrails and watch your step. Ask driver for help if needed. If a step stool or platform has been placed outside the vehicle, please step in the center to maintain your balance.



Handrails - Please refrain from moving around while the tour coach is moving. If you have to get up use the handrails along the overhead compartment to . Use hand supports in the restroom when the vehicle is in motion.



Avoiding Slips and Falls: For your safety, please stay seated while the vehicle is in motion. If you must stand or move along the aisle, support yourself using the seat backs or overhead supports.

Caution - Do not move beyond the marked Ine at the front of the vehicle while it is in motion.



Overhead Luggage Racks - Available for your carry-on bag. Please no fluids in carry-ons. If carry-on is too large to fit in overhead it needs to be checked with driver. Luggage is not permitted to be stored on coach seats.



Emergency Contact - If necessary, notify authorities of an emergency situation by calling 9-1-1.



Driver Directions - In the event of an emergency, remain calm and follow the **EVACUATION** driver's instructions. If you are able, assist the driver with evacuating passengers with disabilities.



Fire Extinguisher - A fire extinguisher is usually located toward the front of the vehicle behind the driver's seat, under a passenger seat on the right side or in an overhead compartment.



Restroom Emergency Button/Switch - If you are in the restroom and need assistance, use the emergency button or switch to alert the driver.
